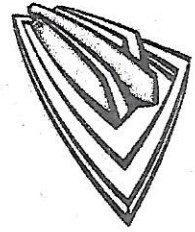
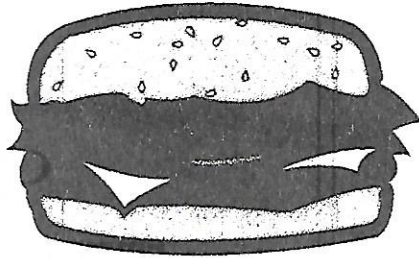
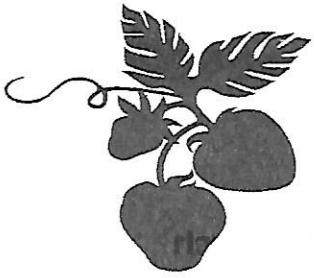
Lauren Klingensmith

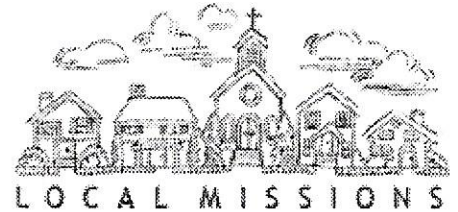

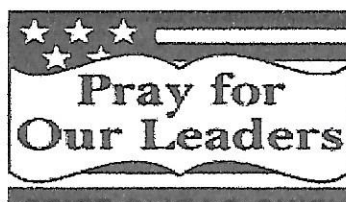

FILIPINO GARLIC FRIED RICE WITH EGGS AND VINEGAR SAUCE (SINANGAG)

**1/2 CUP WHITE VINEGAR
1/4 TSP. CRUSHED RED CHILE FLAKES
14 CLOVES GARLIC, MINCED
KOSHER SALT AND FRESHLY GROUND BLACK PEPPER
1/3 CUP CANOLA OIL
4 CUPS COLD COOKED WHITE RICE
1 SCALLION, THINLY SLICED, FOR GARNISH
FRIED EGGS FOR SERVING**

STIR VINEGAR, CHILE FLAKES, 1 TBSP. GARLIC, SALT AND PEPPER IN A BOWL; SET ASIDE. HEAT OIL IN A SKILLET OVER MEDIUM-HIGH. COOK REMAINING GARLIC UNTIL JUST GOLDEN, 1-2 MINUTES. TRANSFER 2 TBSP. GARLIC TO A PLATE; SET ASIDE, ADD RICE TO SKILLET; COOK, STIRRING AND BREAKING UP ANY LARGE CLUMPS, UNTIL RICE IS HEATED THROUGH AND SLIGHTLY CRISP IN PLACES, 5-7 MINUTES. SEASON WITH SALT AND TRANSFER TO A SERVING PLATTER. TOP WITH FRIED EGGS (WE USED SCRAMBLED EGGS AND MIXED THROUGH THE RICE). SERVE RESERVED SAUCE ON THE SIDE.

1 2/3 CUPS GRAHAM CRACKER CRUMBS

3 1/2 CUPS POWDERED SUGAR

1 CUP BUTTER

1 CUP CREAMY PEANUT BUTTER

1 CUP MILK CHOCOLATE CHIPS

GREASE 9 X 13 PAN WITH BUTTER. COMBINE CRUMBS, SUGAR, BUTTER AND PEANUT BUTTER IN A MIXING BOWL. MIX UNTIL SMOOTH. PRESS DOUGH INTO PAN. MELT CHOCOLATE CHIPS IN A DOUBLE BOILER OR MICROWAVE. SPREAD OVER DOUGH. REFRIGERTE UNTIL FIRM. CUT INTO 1 INCH SQUARES. MAKES 5 DOZENS
