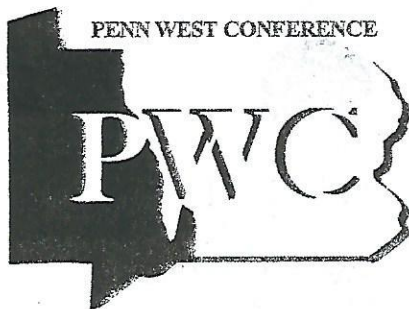


**Luther's 95 Theses**  
**500<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Reformation**

*Continued from last month . . . .*

4. When someone gives you something, learn to say thanks. A thankful heart makes joy. The authors of the Heidelberg Catechism knew this 500 years ago when they wrote: " . . . . Christ, having redeemed us by his blood, is also restoring us by his Spirit into his image, so that with our whole lives we may show that we are thankful to God for his benefits, so that he may be praised through us, so that we may be assured of our faith by its fruits, and so that by our godly living our neighbors may be won over to Christ." And you don't have to be awash in material things or get what you want to be grateful. Psychologists have studied the attitude of gratefulness after a natural disaster and discovered that people who had lost their homes and possessions tended to bounce back quicker if they had an attitude of thankfulness, rather than those who were mad at their circumstances, etc.
5. If you look hard enough you can 'prove' any prejudice you have. If you look even harder, you'll find there's only people. When Jennifer and I were in Germany we encountered prejudice and stereotypes often, our own and others. People told us we acted like 'typical' Americans. Or we would say to each other, "That's just because they are German." The really interesting thing after a year of being overseas was that we started saying things like "That wasn't very German of her" or "Well, he's an odd Frenchman" meaning that they had broken our stereotype of how they should act. At the end of the day, we're all human. We all hurt if we burn our fingers on the stove. No one likes being disrespected. Love and understanding go a long way.
6. When you can't think of anything to do, talk about Jesus. In some ways, going to Germany was a big wake up call for me. I struggled with the language, foreign customs, being a minister in a church that was not at all like my home church (8,000 members!). There was a steep learning curve. But I learned that when the conversation flagged or I didn't have any idea what I was supposed to do, talking with someone about Jesus and his ministry, was a great start. To-do lists are important. Productivity is important. Having rapport with the person sitting across the table is important. Jesus is paramount.

Dear friends in the Penn West Conference,

When I was around twelve or thirteen years old, I remember going to Confirmation Camp at Living Waters. I remember that our theme was the idea of "covenant." I didn't know what a covenant was, but I learned that it was a sacred agreement. I remember being encouraged to make a covenant that week, so I promised God that I'd be as nice to all the other campers as I could be. So I spent a lot of time being sickeningly sweet nice and feeling downright miserable. To top it off, it stormed a lot of those evenings, and in the claps of thunder that echoed through the cabin, I thought God was telling me that I was failing in keeping my covenant. And I felt homesick on top of all that! Then, at one point, I confided in a friend about my misery. My friend said to me, "Just be yourself." After that, the skies cleared (emotionally for me, and, ironically, physically at the camp). I felt like I could be who I was and still keep covenant with God and others. And I could discover joy by being the person God made me to be. It was a powerful lesson that has stayed with me throughout my life. And it wouldn't have happened had I had never gone to Living Waters.

Every fall since I began serving as Conference Minister, I have sent a letter asking for support for the camp during the winter months. The winter is typically a challenging season financially for the camp, and your gifts at this time will go a long way to helping Living Waters into the next calendar year. ## **Pumpkin Smoothie**

- 1 can (15 oz.) Libby's 100% Pure Pumpkin, chilled**
- 1 can (12 fl. oz.) nestle carnation evaporated lowfat 2% milk, chilled**
- 1 1/2 cups orange juice**
- 1 small sliced banana**
- 1/3 cup packed light brown sugar**
- 2 doz. ice cubes (optional)**
- 2 teaspoons ground cinnamon (optional)**

**Place pumpkin, evaporated milk, orange juice, banana and sugar in blender; cover. Blend until smooth. Pour over ice. Sprinkle with cinnamon, if desired. Makes 6 servings.**

## ***Squash and Kale One Pot Pasta***

***12 oz. whole wheat rotini  
3 cloves garlic, minced  
16 oz. peeled and cubed butternut squash  
4 oz. Kale, chopped  
1 1/2 tbsp. dried thyme  
1/4 cup olive oil, divided  
Salt and Pepper  
1 cup grated parmesan cheese***

***Cook pasta in a large pot of salted water, according to package directions. Drain, reserving 2 cups of pasta water.***

***Put pasta water back in pot and add garlic, squash, Kale, thyme and 2 tbsp. olive oil. Season with salt and pepper. Bring to a boil then reduce to a simmer, Stirring frequently until squash is tender, about 10 minutes.***

***Add pasta to vegetables and raise heat to medium.***

***Drizzle with 2 tbsp. olive oil, stir to combine and cook another 5 minutes. Serve topped with cheese. Serves 6.***

Name, address, phone number, title and price (if for sale) must be attached to the back of each artwork. Student artwork may be unframed or mat-framed. Please - no substitutes from pre-registered items.

**ENTRY DONATION:** \$5.00 per adult for a maximum of four pieces of art should be included with entry form. The donation will help defray costs of the show. No commission is taken on sales.

**AWARDS:** A Judge will award ribbons for amateur, experienced, and student categories. The Art Show Committee will award Committee Merit ribbons for works best expressing a Christian thought or teaching. A Popular Award ribbon will be given based on votes by visitors to the show.

**DELIVERY AND PICK-UP:** Artwork should be delivered to the church Fellowship Hall (lower level) on Wednesday or Thursday, November 8th or 9th from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Pick-up of work is on Sunday, November 12th at 4:00 p.m. Please - no early removal of work. 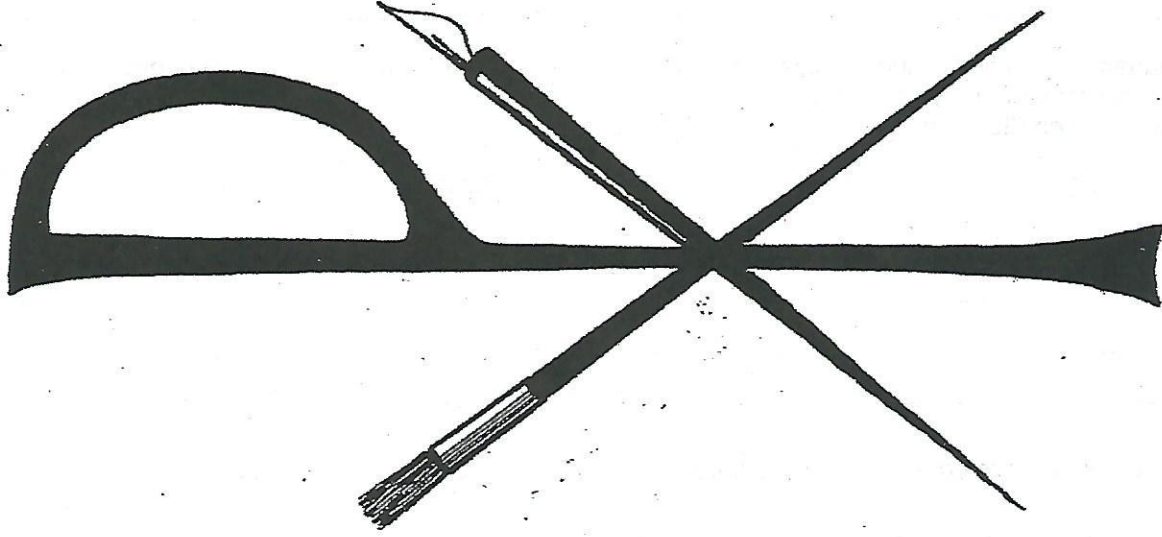
